## 1.0 TERRORIST ROLE OF PAKISTAN

Kashmir is unique among all the crisis points along the Indo-Pakistani border in that a marked escalation of the fighting -- both insurgency and regular -- is virtually inevitable before any effort for a peaceful solution can succeed. The primary reasons is the extent of the ideological commitment and self- interests of several of the key players involved.

For Islamabad, the liberation of Kashmir is a sacred mission, the only task unfulfilled since Muhammad Ali Jinnah's days. Moreover, a crisis in Kashmir constitutes an excellent outlet for the frustration at home, an instrument for the mobilization of the masses, as well as gaining the support of the Islamist parties and primarily their loyalists in the military and the Inter Services Intelligence (ISI).

The ISI has a major interest to continue the crisis. Back in the 1970s, Pakistan started to train Sikhs and other Indian separatist movements as part of Zulfikar Ali Bhutto's strategy for forward strategic depth. **Pakistan adopted the sponsorship of terrorism and subversion** as an instrument to substitute for the lack of strategic depth and early warning capabilities. The Pakistani sponsored terrorists and the Pakistani intelligence operatives in their ranks would be able to warn Pakistan of any impending Indian invasion, and then launch guerrilla warfare against the Indian Army even before it reached the border with Pakistan. Therefore, sponsoring separatist subversion has become a crucial component of Islamabad's national military strategy.

The following articles will provide you with an in-depth analysis of Pakistan's involvement in instigating and supporting terrorism in Kashmir by establishing various training centers for providing arms training to many Kashmiri Muslim youths who are lured out of their homes in Kashmir to cross over the border - all in the name of religion for fighting a **Jehad** (holy war) against Infidel India.

## 2.0 ARMING OF MILITANTS



Weapons Seized

"In Kashmir Valley an insurgency is going on. But it is not by the local community. There is a lot of evidence to suggest the insurgency is organised, assisted and triggered by forces outside India. I mention here Pakistan, which is conducting training camps.... I also met four captured militants: one Afghan, one Palestinian and other Pakistanis. They admitted that they fought in Afghanistan and Kashmir at the behest of Pakistan. A large cache of arms made in different countries and seized from the militants were shown to me. We want to cut off support to insurgency whatever the source.

The following are extracts from two reports "Pakistan's Kashmir Strategy" a report of the Freeman Centre for Strategic studies, and "The New Islamic International" a report of the Task Force on Terrorism and Unconventional Warfare of the House Republican Research Committee U.S. house of representatives, Washington D.C.

....Meanwhile the ISI continues to provide the terrorists with new weapons. In the summer of 1993, the Kashmiri Mujahideen were provided with long range and powerful missiles - Saqr missiles of Afghan war vintage. At that time, the Kashmiri and ISI crews were being trained in the use of these missiles in Pakistani Kashmir.



Subsequently there has been a marked expansion of smuggling of quality weapons from Pakistan in to Kashmir as of late 1993. There has been a corresponding change in the terrorists' tactics, introducing hit and run strikes by highly trained and well equipped detachments. Among the new weapons now used in Kashmir are 107mm rockets, 60mm mortars, automatic grenade launchers (Soviet and Chinese models), modification of 57 mm helicopter rocket pods with solar powered sophisticated timing device for delayed firing barrages of rockets, and LAW-type tube-launched ATMs (Soviet and Chinese models). A threshold was crossed in the spring of 1994 when the ISI began providing the Kashmiri Islamists with Stinger SAMs. Indian security forces captured a stinger on 30 April 1994.....

....Islamabad also uses the escalation in Kashmir as a cover for the overall expansion of the terrorist training and support for operations in Central Asia and elsewhere in the world. In order to escalate their Islamist Jihad, the ISI established in early 1990s, the *Markaz Dawar*, a centre for world wide Islamist activities.....

....For Islamabad the liberation of Kashmir is a sacred mission, the only task unfulfilled since Muhammed Ali Jinnah's days.

Islamabad desperately needs an external challenge for its own domestic political reasons, ranging from diversion of popular attention away from the domestic collapse to finding "something to do " for the ISI and the military rather than meddling in politics."

Meanwhile, the ISI translated its major paramilitary command into a major political force. Now there is a need for a mission use for the ISI's numerous para-military and Afghan forces, as well as an institutional interest in preserving the political clout that comes with these operations. **Islamabad finds a task for the ISI's vast Pakistani and Afghan cadres** previously involved in sponsoring the Jihad in Afghanistan, but who are now no longer needed, that would keep them away from domestic politics and power struggles.

In early June 1994, Commander Manzur Shah declared that the sole objective of the escalating Jihad in Kashmir is to incorporate it into Pakistan. He admitted that Indian Kashmiri Muslim leaders were assassinated or attacked in order to prevent them from reaching an agreement with the Indian government. " Wali Mohammed would not have been assassinated and the caravans of Farooq (Abdullah) and Rajesh Pilot would not have been attacked if the climate was conducive to political action"

Meanwhile, a campaign of assassinations was launched in order to eliminate the Kashmiri civic leadership that opposed the escalation of the Jihad. On June 20 1994, Islamist terrorists assassinated the Kashmiri Scholar Qazi Nissar Ahmed. He was kidnapped a night before and pressured to endorse the anti-India Jihad. He refused and was killed. A key member of the assassination was Fayaz Ahmad Mir a.k.a. Abu

Bakr of Hizb-ul-Mujahideen. Ahmed was the 17th Kashmiri Muslim Scholar to be assassinated by Islamists for refusing to join the anti-India struggle.

The strategic logic of using the nuclear factor to offset any deficiencies in conventional military power has been the cornerstone of Pakistan's nuclear strategy. Recently a more assertive element was first introduced to the nuclear strategy by Islamist politicians. The overall Pakistani strategic confidence has been expressed in brinkmanship statements coming out of Islamabad since the fall of 1993. For example, Qazi Hussain Ahmad, the Jamaat-i-Islami Chief Senator, urged the Bhutto government "to declare *Jihad* on India to save Kashmiri Muslims from total annihilation. " There is no other way to resolve the crisis he declared. "Let us wage *Jihad* for Kashmir. A nuclear armed Pakistan would deter India from a wider conflict." he stressed. Thus the statement of mid February confirms that the Bhutto government has indeed adopted the strategy and policy outlined by the Islamists.

As the spring of 1995 draws near and the weather improves, the ISI is about to unleash a new cycle of terrorism and subversion. Considering the extent of the training, preparations and organizational effort invested in the Kashmiri Islamist insurgency during the last few years, it is safe to assume that fighting in Kashmir will escalate markedly in the coming year. Numerous additional highly trained and well equipped Mujahideen, many of them professional specialist forces and terrorists, will join the fighting in Kashmir and will even expand the struggle into the rest of India. They already have in place extensive stockpiles of weapons as well as large sums of money to sustain and support their *Jihad*. Their primary mission, however, will not be for the liberation of Kashmir but rather furthering the strategic interests of Islamabad.....

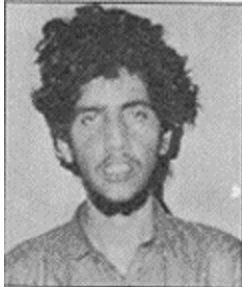
## Revelations of Arrested Mercenaries

**Mohd Arif Khan alias Wahid alias Rashid Ahmand Bhatt,**  
son of Alamuddin Khan, resident of Dastgir Mohalla,  
Karachi, Pakistan. HUA ( arrested on 5.5.95 )

He received 80 days weapon training in HUA run training camp at 'Maskar' in the midst of jungle near Afghan border. Inducted in May 94 through Lolab Valley-Bandipur. Arrested on Indo-Bangladesh border, while he was on way to Pakistan.

**Mohd Irfan alias Anwar,**  
s/o Mohd Ayub Khan,  
r/o Tanda Gujarat,  
Pakistan ( arrested on 29.3.95 )

His father is a retired Pakistan Air Force personnel. Pakistan ISI operative Mohd Irfan disclosed that he was involved in 14-trans-border operations at the behest of Pakistan ISI unit based in Sialkot for the purpose of inducting arms/ammunition and explosives to Indian side and for sabotage activities. The bomb explosions during Republic Day function in Jammu ( Jan. 26, 1995 ) was planned by Sialkot unit of Pakistan ISI in consultation with local JEI/HuM leaders. He planted two explosive devices at MAM Stadium, Jammu. During his fourteenth and last trip to Indian side, Mohd Irfan and his associates were to target the supply lines in Jammu area including the Petrol Pumps, Railway Stations, Power Supply lines, Electric Sub-Stations and Transformers.



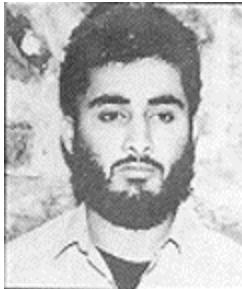
**Nadeem Abbasi alias Asim Abbasi**

s/o Yusuf Abbasi,

Muzaffarabad. IJT/HuM ( arrested on 16.5.95 )

Imparted religious training for 13 days followed by training in handling of arms at 'Al Badar' training camp, run by JEI on Afghanistan border during April 1993. Later, he was further given two and a half months arms training by HuM in handling of fire arms including LMGs, PK guns, sniper rifles, RPGs.

**Mohd Hassan Shafiq alias Abu Jindal,**  
s/o late Imdadulah  
r/o Chinant, Jheena,  
Pakistan. HUA ( arrested on 12.5.95 ).

Afghan war veteran. He had received Islamic education in Dar-ul-Uloom, Kabirwal, Khannewal, (Harkat-ul-Ansar) and was imparted 12 days arms training in 1988 in Khost, Afghanistan. Inducted into the Valley in Sept. 94 with arms and ammunition. He was shifted to Charar-e-Sharief town in Jan. 95. Disclosed that the shrine complex was set ablaze by Mast Gul.



**Shaheed Mehmood Mughal alias Abu Darda alias Hamid alias Bhola,**

s/o Ali Afsar Mugal,  
r/o Bangni, Rawalkot,  
Pakistan Occupied Kashmir. LET ( arrested on 3.9. 95 )

Volunteered to participate in 'jihad' in Kashmir. He received 21 days initial training in fire arms at Maskar-e-Taiba camp, Kunah, Afghanistan and then 3 months commando training course near Nissar Pakistan Army camp on Muzaffarabad-Athmuqam Road. He was inducted into the Kashmir Valley in May 94 with group of a 25 Lashkar-E-Taiba cadres.





**Nasir Mehmood Sodozey alias Aftab**

s/o Shafi Mohd,

Police Station Palandari, Dist.  
Rawalakot, Poonch (POK)  
Finance Chief HUA ( arrested on 25.4.96 )

Motivated jointly by Maulana Fazl-ur-Rehman Khalil and Farooq Kashmiri. He went extensive arms training at the HUA run Yawar camp ( Afghanistan ) in 1990. Disclosed that he was in constant touch with ISI officials. Inducted into the Valley by HUA leadership in Pakistan to channelise funds to alien mercenaries associated with HUA operating in Jammu & Kashmir.



**Sajid Ali Jut alias Sage Ahmed,**

s/o Bashir Ahmed  
r/o Nissar Colony,  
Muzaffarabad, Pakistan Occupied Kashmir  
(arrested on 2.10.95 )

Imparted 15 days arms at Dudhnial. Inducted in Sept. 94 in a group of 5 through Uri sector ( Baramullah ) from Keil ( Pakistan Occupied Kashmir ), where Pakistan ISI gave them weapons.



**Talib Hussain Malik alias Mohd Aslam Malik**

s/o Qunizullah, r/o H.No. p-157, Buffer Zone, Karachi,  
Pakistan ( arrested on 13.11.95 )

Made six clandestine trips to Jammu & Kashmir during 1990-95 at the instance of these ISI officials and brought Rs 1,28,000 and \$500 and 6 AK series rifles, 6 pistols, besides ammunition. Assigned to cause bomb blasts in Jammu to disturb the election process.

Sajjad Haider alias Abid Bhai  
s/o Late Mushtaq Ahmed Shah  
r/o House No. 33, w/6 Madina town,  
Faisalabad, Pakistan.

JEI/HuM/Al Barq ( arrested on 6.2.1996 )

15-days arms training at JEI-run Al Badar camp in Khost area and later one month intensive training in handling of sophisticated arms in April 1993 at an ISI-run camp in the jungle of Atock. Infiltrated into the Valley in April 1995 to thwart elections in the State of J&K at any cost. Pak ISI maintained launching camps in POK at Athmuqam, Khojabandi, Leepa, Zora, Dudhnial, Tejian, Sharda, Keil, Sonadh, Nowseri Toab ( across Gurez ) and Chailas (Gilgit) to induct trained Kashmiri/alien mercenaries into the Valley.



**Mohd. Mohsin Malik alias Abu Zahid alias Darshan Lal**

s/o Mohd. Arif Malik  
r/o Village Bhagwanpura, Lahore,  
Pakistan. LET ( arrested on 30.4.96 )

Affiliated to Lashkar-E-Taiba/Markaz-e-Dawa-al-Irshad. Underwent arms training in Asthabad. Received training at the age of 14 years. Specialised one month course at Muzaffarabad, covering knowledge about explosives/IEDs and urban warfare. Immediate task was to liquidate VIPs, in conjunction with Sikh militants.



**Abdul Matin alias Mosaib**

s/o Haji Mohd. Yaqub  
r/o Mirpur, Mathelo,  
Distt. Sukur, Pakistan. Deputy Distt.  
Comdr, HUA ( arrested on 5.5.97 )

Infiltrated into the Kashmir Valley in Sept. 1994 in a group of 15. Toured different cities, including Delhi, Calcutta, Deoband, Muzaffarpur, Agra, Meerut, Shimla during Nov. 1996 - Jan. 1997. He revealed that Pakistan had a plan to induct Talibans in the Valley. Admitted to have been responsible for the explosions in a Jaipur Stadium on "Republic Day" ( Jan./Feb 1996). Imparted training at Khalidbin Walid training camp, Jawar-Pakhia (Afghanistan).

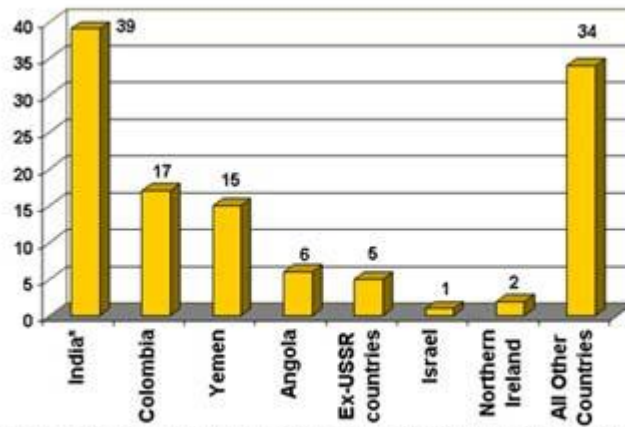

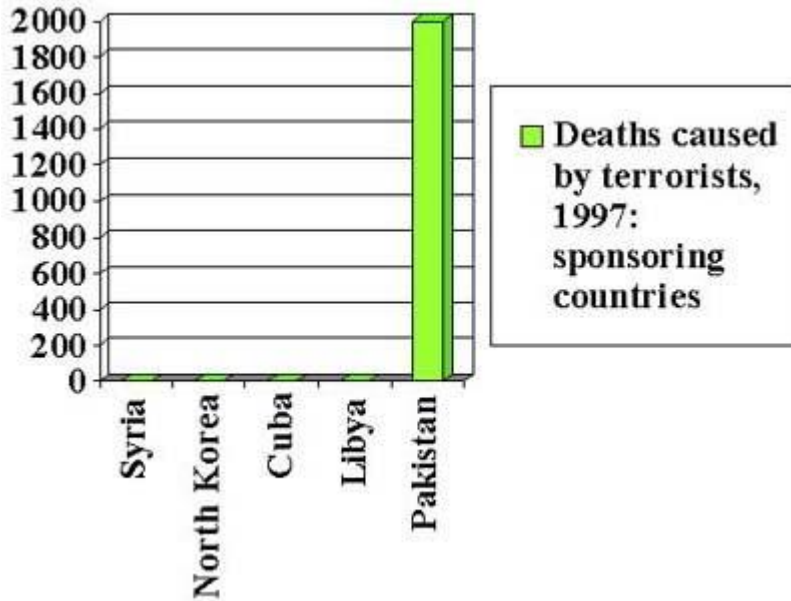
Significant Terrorism Incidents in 1998

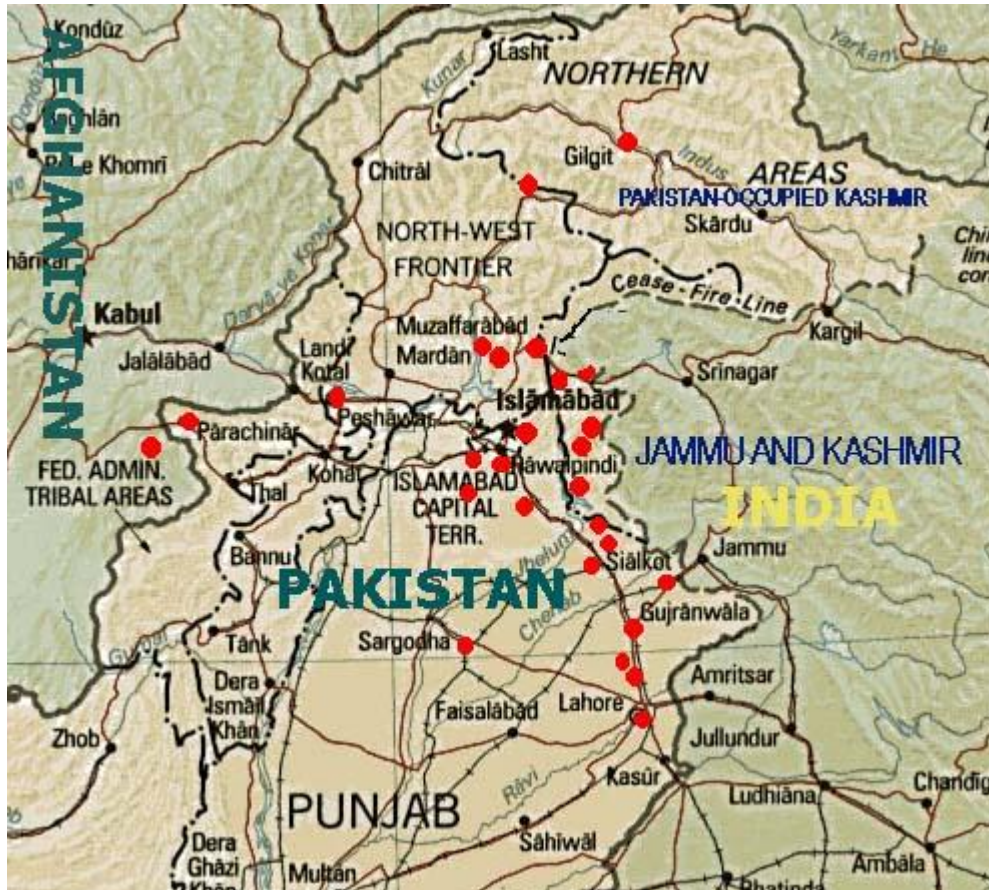

They are presumably listed for previous acts of terrorism, for non-compliance with international resolutions, or for harboring terrorist groups. The Pakistani data is derived from an average of over 2,000 deaths in the state of Jammu and Kashmir during the last several years in violence by Pakistani-supported terrorists.

- Number of Terrorist Camps in Pakistan: 37
- Number of Terrorist Camps in Pakistan-occupied Kashmir: 49
- Number of Pakistani-run Terrorist Camps in Afghanistan: 22
- Total Number of Hardcore Terrorists Operating in Jammu and Kashmir: 2300
- Total Number of Foreign Mercenaries Operating in Jammu and Kashmir: 900
- Number of Pakistani terrorists killed by Indian security forces: 291
- Number of Pakistani terrorists in Indian jails: 125
- Number of Indian civilians killed by Pakistani terrorists: over 29,000

- Number of firearms recovered from Pakistan-trained terrorists in India: 47,000
- Amount of explosives recovered from Pakistan-trained terrorists in India: 60 tons (30,000 kg)

- Peak time of annual infiltration of terrorists into India:
  - Summer months, when the snows have melted, under cover of Pakistani Army firing (Washington Post, Oct. 15, 1998).
- Number of people in Jammu and Kashmir killed in violence waged by Pakistan-supported terrorists over the last decade: **over 20,000**.
- Ethnic Cleansing in Kashmir: Nearly **300,000 Kashmiri Pandits** (original Hindu inhabitants of Kashmir valley) driven out of their ancestral homeland by Pakistan-supported terrorists.
- Pakistan's response to charges of terrorism support: "It only provides diplomatic and moral support to the terrorists". To see through this outright lie, read about the "credible reports of official Pakistani support to Kashmiri terrorist groups..." in the US State Department 1997 report on global terrorism.
- The US Tomahawk missiles killed Pakistani terrorists belonging to Harkat-ul-Ansar in the Khost camps in Afghanistan this year. These terrorists were training to fight in Kashmir.
- The Harkat-ul-Ansar and the Lashkar-e-Toiba threatened US citizens recently in open news conferences in major cities in Pakistan. The Pakistani government makes no attempt to shut down any of these groups.
- Most recent recruits to Pakistani terrorist camps: Kashmiri Muslim children as young as 12 years old, coerced into a dead-end career by Pakistani terrorist groups (CNN Online, Oct. 8, 1998).
- Why is the Pakistani economy in shambles? 70% of its budget goes to the military plus its debt payments, much of the military spending being on sustaining the Kashmiri terror (NY Times, Aug. 30, 1998, The Tribune, Oct. 10, 1998).
